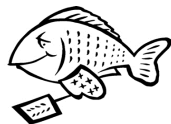

Music starts at 6pm.**

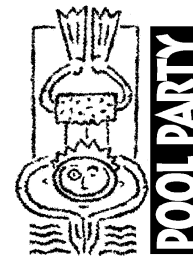

There will be a Camp Meeting at 4:30pm this afternoon. Parents and students need to be present.

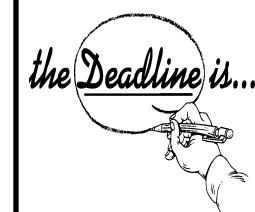
This Wednesday we will not have Youth Group because we will be at camp.

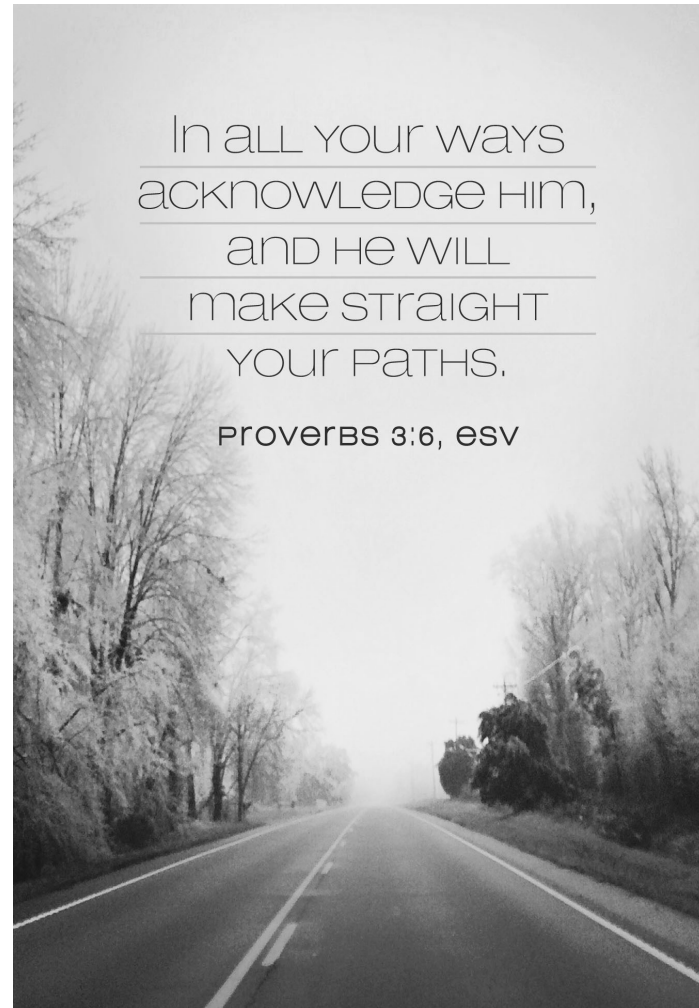
