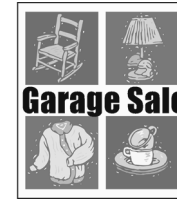

The next Garage Sale will be on Saturday, **September 30th**. Donations can be brought to the designated room in the Education Building.

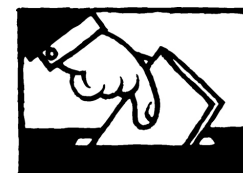
Disciples Path
