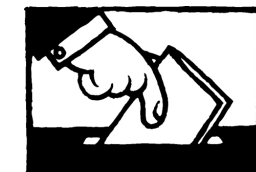

Youth Evangelism Celebration (YEC) is coming up. It will be **Nov 19-20** in Lafayette. More details to come. Signup online, or in the Refuge.

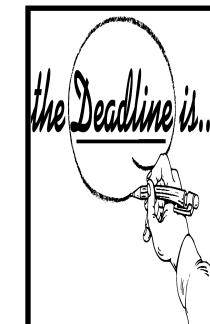
FOOD DISTRIBUTION MINISTRY
