

Pastor's Lines

Dear Church Family,

We are so thankful that our Kids Konnection children are leading in worship today. They have worked really hard on a musical/drama presentation that centers around the call of God. Our children are being called by God to serve Him in innumerable ways. As a church family, we have the privilege and distinct responsibility to nurture the call so that the children can be in the center of God's will. As they hear and interpret the call of God over their lifetime, they will be fulfilled and experience a greater purpose in life because of the call of God.

So the question will probably be asked, "How can you know that a "call" is from God? Here are a few test questions to help us answer the call.

1. Am I studying Scripture? Do I know the themes of the Bible that are consistent throughout? God is not going to call you to something that disagrees with the Scriptures.
2. Am I disciplined in my prayer life? Is the voice of God familiar to me, as I talk and listen to Him in all matters? (I was listening to talk radio the other day, and I heard a voice that sounded familiar. Sure enough, by the end of the call on the radio, I was able to identify the voice as an old friend.) Voices never leave our head.
3. Does "the call" require faith? In other words, are the actions of God calling me to some action that is reasonable or a little scary? (go with scary)
4. Can I do anything else and avoid the call? This question helped me enter the ministry. I was miserable and realized that all I wanted to do was minister for the Lord.
5. Will God be honored by my answer, "Yes"
6. Am I ready NOW! ?

I want to encourage our children to heed the call of God: to missions, to ministry, to a vocation that honors God, to salvation and baptism.

The Lord Calls

I Samuel 1-17

1 The boy Samuel ministered before the LORD under Eli. In those days the word of the LORD was rare; there were not many visions.

2 One night Eli, whose eyes were becoming so weak that he could barely see, was lying down in his usual place.

3 The lamp of God had not yet gone out, and Samuel was lying down in the house of the LORD, where the ark of God was.

4 Then the LORD called Samuel. Samuel answered, “Here I am.”

5 And he ran to Eli and said, “Here I am; you called me.” But Eli said, “I did not call; go back and lie down.” So he went and lay down.

6 Again the LORD called, “Samuel!” And Samuel got up and went to Eli and said, “Here I am; you called me.” “My son,” Eli said, “I did not call; go back and lie down.”

7 Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD: The word of the LORD had not yet been revealed to him.

8 A third time the LORD called, “Samuel!” And Samuel got up and went to Eli and said, “Here I am; you called me.” Then Eli realized that the LORD was calling the boy.

9 So Eli told Samuel, “Go and lie down, and if he calls you, say, ‘Speak, LORD, for your servant is listening.’” So Samuel went and lay down in his place.

10 The LORD came and stood there, calling as at the other times, “Samuel! Samuel!” Then Samuel said, “Speak, for your servant is listening.”

11 And the LORD said to Samuel: “See, I am about to do something in Israel that will make the ears of everyone who hears about it tingle.

12 At that time I will carry out against Eli everything I spoke against his family—from beginning to end.

13 For I told him that I would judge his family forever because of the sin he knew about; his sons blasphemed God, and he failed to restrain them.

14 Therefore I swore to the house of Eli, ‘The guilt of Eli’s house will never be atoned for by sacrifice or offering.’”

15 Samuel lay down until morning and then opened the doors of the house of the LORD. He was afraid to tell Eli the vision,

16 but Eli called him and said, “Samuel, my son.” Samuel answered, “Here I am.”

17 “What was it he said to you?” Eli asked. “Do not hide it from me. May God deal with you, be it ever so severely, if you hide from me anything he told you.”

18 So Samuel told him everything, hiding nothing from him. Then Eli said, “He is the LORD; let him do what is good in his eyes.
