

MISSIONS COMMITTEE

MISSION STATEMENT: To create a Godly hunger in the church for support of missions locally and around the globe.

OBJECTIVE: To recommend, approve, and manage mission activities. Activities will be funded by the Mission Fund of FBCJ and supplemented by special offerings and gifts as needed, with a significant level of financial and biblical responsibilities as approved by the church using the Acts 1:8 model.

COMMITTEE STRUCTURE: To consist of four (4) members, enlisted by the Committee on Committees, voted upon by the church, to serve a three (3) year term, working under the direction of the Committee Chair. Chairman has the additional responsibility of serving on Church Council. The WMU Director is a fifth member of the Committee and does not rotate off. The Ministerial Staff serve as Ex-Officio members and are advisors/consultants without voting privileges.

TASKS: (All tasks are to conform to FBCJ Bylaws.)

- Involve the church in methods for spreading the gospel to as many people as possible.
- Present information to the congregation about local, national, and international missions, to encourage personal service and giving by church members.
- Keep the church abreast of opportunities for personal involvement in actual mission activities, by communicating through various methods deemed appropriate.
- Encourage committee members to engage in formal and informal missions training opportunities.
- Coordinate training opportunities to church members who will engage in mission activities.
- Report annually to the church, mission activities accomplished and financial disbursements. Report to be given at January business meeting for the previous year.
