

TRUSTEES

MISSION STATEMENT: To hold in trust all of the properties of the church in a manner pleasing to God.

OBJECTIVE: To give oversight and advice as needed in any legal matters concerning the church properties.

COMMITTEE STRUCTURE: Six (6) members nominated by the Committee on Committees and voted on by the church. The Financial Secretary shall serve as an Ex-officio member of the Trustees. The Ministerial Staff serve as Ex-Officio members and are advisors/consultants without voting privileges.

TASKS: (All tasks are to conform to FBCJ Bylaws & the Articles of Incorporation.)

- Hold in trust the church property.
- Submit to church for approval any recommendations concerning financial arrangement with any financial institution.
- Buy, sell, mortgage, lease or transfer any church property, or accept donations of property to the church, after a specific vote of the church authorizing each action.
- Submit to the church for approval any legal transaction and legal advice.
- Recommend to the church an audit of the financial accounts when deemed necessary.
- When the signatures of Trustees are required, a minimum of two Trustees shall sign legal documents involving the sale, mortgage, purchase or rental of property, or other legal documents relating to approved church matters.
