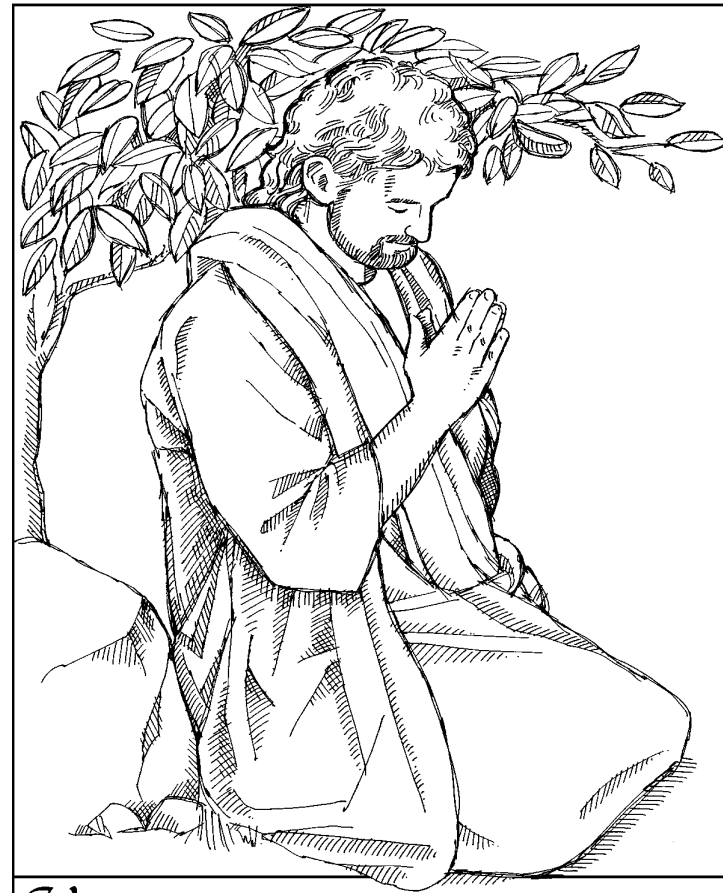

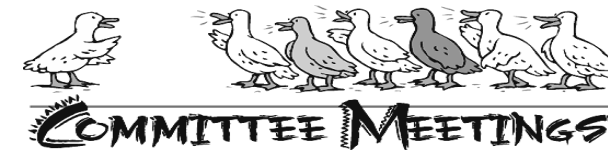
Parents and Children **MARK YOUR CALENDAR**
