### Dear Church,

What is faith? The Bible gives us a great definition: Hebrews 11:1, "*Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.*" Does that mean faith is blind? No! The Bible gives us much to have confidence in.

In Luke Chapter 8, Jesus gives Peter a chance to show his faith. He offers him the opportunity to walk on water. Peter can hope to walk on water all he wants, but he will never accomplish it unless he trusts what Jesus has told him. He can't let the fear of the storm around him keep him from getting out of the boat. Peter can't walk on water unless he has the faith to step out of the boat.

How do we express our faith today? First, we believe, then we have faith in advance that God will fulfill His promises. Faith is expressed by action. We step out in faith believing God will do what He said He will do.

What do you hope for? Is it your own selfish desires or do you hope for God's Will? What is God asking you to step out in faith for? Is it surrendering your life to Jesus? Is it confessing a stronghold in your life? Is it forgiving someone? Is it faithfully tithing? Too many times, we are afraid of the storm. "What will people say if I become a Christian? I'm too embarrassed to admit my addiction. You don't know what that person did to me! The economy is so uncertain..."
